Table 1-1 summarises the categories of affiliation and designation that are relevant to ACRP's *Council for General Ministry Practitioners (CGMP)* and *Council for Ministry Training Practitioners (CMTP)*. It also shows the qualifications or requirements related to the different categories, the Continued Professional Development (CPD) types that are relevant to designated persons in the various categories. (The table was compiled, taking into account the type of scenarios experienced in the past while processing CGMP and CMTP affiliation applications.) Table 1-2 shows the affiliation categories relevant to the *Council for Pastoral and Spiritual Counsellors (CPSC)*.
